9.30 Mark Wilson (UK) Cochrane: Past, Present and Future

Apart from Mark Wilson's presentation, the Meeting will be in Italian. In the morning in one room on the following topic: Cochrane and Cochrane PRM. In the afternoon in two rooms the following topics will be presented:

- Room 1: Cochrane evidence in neurology, cardiorespiratory diseases
- Room 2: Cochrane evidence in musculoskeletal disorders, other PRM fields; how to produce

General information

The Exploratory Meeting will last one day on Monday: it will start with a welcome cocktail in the evening of Sunday and will conclude with a dinner on Monday. On Tuesday there will be a Meeting in Italian about the contents and organization of Cochrane. Mark Wilson (CEO of Cochrane) will give a lecture in English at the start of the Meeting, and participants to the Exploratory Meeting are obviously welcome.

The Exploratory Meeting will be in Rovato at the Don Gnocchi Hospital, where the EBM Centre that will host Cochrane PRM will be located. We advise participant to stay in Brescia: transportation by car will be organized to Rovato.

Participation include free of charge:

- Welcome cocktail on Sunday September 18th with transportation
- Exploratory Meeting on Monday September 19th with lunch and transportation from and to Brescia
- Dinner on Monday September 19th in Brescia
- Meeting in Italian on Tuesday September 20th (lunch and coffee breaks to be defined)

We suggest to stay in Brescia downtown. Brescia has an underground very easy to use. Cars will leave or from Piazza Vittoria (middle of the town) or the Station – both places very well reachable by underground.

Brescia can easily be reached in 45 minutes by high speed train from Central Station in Milano. Central Station can be reached from Milan Malpensa Airport (MXP) by train, and from Milan Linate Airport (LIN) by bus. Arriving in Milan Bergamo Airport (BGY), where many low cost companies land, the best option is a direct bus that takes in almost 30 minutes to Brescia downtown.

Registration to the Meeting is required for organizational reasons by September 10 (best as soon as possible). Please fill the attached Registration Form. You can also find a list of possible hotels for your stay.
